Donor Consent/Agreement

Your dog, _____, upon passing screening tests, will currently be enrolled in our volunteer blood donor program.

Donor Benefits: Volunteer canine donors must be up to date on vaccinations and be on heartworm prevention. In exchange for donating six times yearly, donors will receive free of charge:

- Blood typing
- Wellness Exams
- Yearly blood health screening and infectious disease screening (\$300 value)
- Heartworm testing
- Fecal parasite screens
- Urine evaluations
- Vaccinations once in the program for one year

Risks: While risks are minimal, some risks in blood donation programs do exist. These risks apply to human or canine blood donors just the same. These risks include swelling at the blood draw site, hematoma formation, and temporary weakness after donation. While these risks do not pose long term harm to your pet, we will do everything possible to prevent these risks. For dogs that need sedation to donate, some minimal risks of sedation can occur. These include vomiting, weakness after donation, and rarely death. Most canine donors do not need to be sedated to donate blood. For those that do, minimal sedation, just enough to calm them to allow donation are administered. Again, we will do everything possible to prevent these risks.

If any adverse effects to donation occur, please contact us and we will treat your pet at no cost to you.
